



Logistics Officer Association Guidance Chief Learning Officer (G-10)

1. Purpose: To identify the roles and responsibilities of the LOA Chief Learning Officer (CLO).
2. Duties and Responsibilities:
 - a. Identify and communicate opportunities for members to gain education, training, and experience in pursuit of logistics and acquisitions professional development. Enhance members knowledge and understanding of key logistics processes, covering a broad range of capabilities (e.g., IT, Cyber, SCM, AGILE).
 - b. Engage with chapters to provide professional education in logistics throughout the year.
 - c. Participate in forums provided by LOA to communicate education and training opportunities.
3. During the LOA Symposium, the CLO will perform duties as the Dean of LOA University (LOA U). LOA U is dedicated to exposing members to education, training, and experience in order to enhance the depth and breadth of their logistics knowledge. Duties are as follows:
 - a. Secure instructors for sessions during LOA's National Symposium.
 - b. Collaborate with faculty, instructors, and other leaders from government and non-government education and training institutions to develop comprehensive educational learning sessions.
 - c. Collect feedback from attendees and instructors to determine lessons learned and ways to improve for the future. Provide the LOA Executive Board a feedback report after the symposium.
 - d. Continually enhance and advance the curriculum to reflect the needs of members and the greater logistics communities.

4. Any other related duties as determined by the LOA Executive Board.
